## DRESS AND APPEARANCE

We do not encourage the wearing of jewellery in school, for example necklaces, rings etc. If watches are worn (older children who can tell the time), we ask for them to be named. **No jewellery will be allowed during PE for health and safety reasons. Earrings cannot be worn - children must be able to remove them themselves.** Please note, no earrings or jewellery are to be worn by children in Foundation Stage. If children do have their ears pierced, please have it done at the start of the 6 week summer holiday.

Short grey trousers  
School sweatshirt  
Black shoes (not trainers)

### INFANT GIRLS SUMMER UNIFORM

Blue/white summer dress (**playsuits are NOT permitted**)  
Sweatshirt/school cardigan  
White socks  
Black shoes

### JUNIOR BOYS UNIFORM

White shirt and school tie  
Grey long/short trousers  
School 'V' neck jumper  
Grey socks  
Black shoes (not trainers)

### JUNIOR GIRLS UNIFORM

White blouse and school tie  
Grey pinafore/skirt  
School 'V' neck jumper  
White socks  
Black shoes

### JUNIOR BOYS SUMMER UNIFORM

White polo shirt  
Grey long/short trousers  
School Jumper  
Grey socks  
Black shoes (not trainers)

### JUNIOR GIRLS SUMMER UNIFORM

Option of blue check/stripe summer dress  
or white polo shirt and grey skirt  
School jumper/cardigan  
White short socks  
Black shoes

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM (Boys and Girls)

House coloured T shirt (green/blue/red/yellow) with school logo  
Plain black shorts  
Black plimsolls (not trainers)  
Optional football socks  
Pump bag (**named on the outside**)

**Please name ALL items of clothing and possessions**

School uniform can be purchased from Bispham Clothing, All Hallows Road, Bispham.

We no longer provide zip-up bookbags, which take up a lot of space, but clear plastic wallets so that reading books and letters can easily be spotted!

Pump bags are usually sent home at the end of each half-term and returned after the holiday. Please do not send a 'back pack' to school as they are too large and do not fit in our cloakroom areas.

Extremes of fashion, both in terms of clothing or personal appearance are not allowed in school. All shoulder length/long hair must be tied back with a red, white or blue bobble, band or scrunchie. Boys hair should not be shaved below a grade 2 and we request that patterns are not shaved into the head as this is inappropriate for school. By drawing attention to themselves in this way, children open themselves to potential ridicule and distract other pupils from their work. We also ask that children do not wear nail varnish in school. In common with all other schools in the country, the Principal reserves the right to make the final decision regarding matters of this nature.

Mobile phones are not encouraged, but if deemed essential, must be handed in to the school office at the start of the school day.
